



Marko Tušek: Observation 28 March–26 April 2025 artKIT

You are cordially invited to the opening of the solo exhibition *Observation* by the Slovenian artist, painter, designer and photographer Marko Tušek, which will take place on Friday, 28 March 2025, at 6 p.m. in the artKIT exhibition space.

Marko Tušek builds and creates works of art that have abandoned the canvas as a support for painting and have developed into a three-dimensional surface fullness of the painterly body. The gaze leads us to spatial traces of gold, while the bodies of the paintings captivate us with their visual vitality and the esthetic intensity of diverse relief marvels and compositional colorfulness of the elements.

The body of the painting is the most important building block for the concrete threedimensional appearance of the painting. Starting from the formerly two-dimensional canvas, the body of the painting is structurally rearranged and layered on several levels. The artist circles around questions such as: What is painting today and what is contemporary painting. By exploring fundamental and borderline questions, he slowly and gradually evolves his art and painting, providing answers as we enter the visual interior of the painting.
